- To determining whether the project has been successfully commissioned in accordance with project implementation plan submitted along with the application or any amendment subsequently incorporated therein with the prior approval of the Authority;
- To determining whether the licensee is complying with the requirements of the Ordinance, rules, regulations, standards prescribed by the Authority, the terms and conditions of its licence or the project implementation plan submitted by it along with the application or any amendment subsequently incorporated therein with the prior approval of the Authority.
- To carry out full review and audit of the LNG Projects on behalf of OGRA.
- Review the technical, administrative, financial, and commercial capabilities of the project developer in relation to the regulated activity.
- To conform that the project satisfies criteria for design, construction, and operation of the LNG terminal as specified in the prevalent LNG Policy.
- To certify the viability of the sources of supply of LNG and the applicant's demonstrated access thereto.
