Govt plans to provide over 1.3m new gas connections in 2021-22

ISLAMABAD - Despite severe gas shortage during the winter season in the country, the government has set an ambitious target to add 1,333,938 new consumers in 2021-22 to the network of SNGPL and SSGC, which is 370 percent higher than the connections provided by both the gas utilities companies during current fiscal.

SNGPL, SSGC gasify 70 villages in eight months

ISLAMABAD - The two state companies, SNGPL and SSGC, have provided gas facility to around 70 villages and towns during first eight months (July-February) of the current fiscal year. Besides, the companies laid 143 KMs gas transmission network, 2,616 KMs distribution and 886 KMs services lines across their operational areas, according to the Economic Survey 2020-21 unveiled by Minister for Finance and Revenue Shaukat Tarin here at a press conference.
