ISLAMABAD - Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) has refused to determine RLNG price for Pakistan LNG Limited for the supply of the import gas to KE's 900MW power plant saying that costs attributable to KE as per the terms of Gas Sales Agreement (GSA) are not admissible to be recovered from RLNG price under its current pricing regime being not consistent with the guidelines of the federal government.
